Open Futurity

- *Futurities are for three year old horses only
- * All NRCHA rules apply
- *To Enter Stallion Incentive you must enter the 3 year old Open Snaffle Bit Futurity or the Level One Open Futurity.
- * Only horses nominated to the Saskatchewan Stallion Incentive are eligible for Stallion Incentive.
- * SRCHA membership required if entering Stallion Incentive class

Non Pro Futurity

- *Futurities are for three year old horses only
- Open to approved Non Pro riders only (NRCHA rule) for more info see NRCHA Non Pro definitions and rules**
- * All NRCHA rules apply
- * To enter stallion incentive you must enter the Non Pro or level 1 NP Snaffle Bit Futurity. Only horses nominated to the Saskatchewan Stallion Incentive are eligible for Stallion Incentive
- * SRCHA membership required to compete in Stallion Incentive Classes

Non Pro Boxing Futurity

- *Open to approved Non Pro Boxing riders who comply with all NRCHA non pro eligibility rules and meet requirements of ownership rule
- * Show in rein box class competing on a 3yr old horse in a regulation snaffle bit,
- * To enter stallion incentive you must enter the 3 year old Non Pro Boxing Futurity. Only horses nominated to the Saskatchewan Stallion Incentive are eligible for Stallion Incentive.
- * SRCHA membership required to compete in Stallion Incentive Classes
- * All NRCHA rules apply

Open Derby

- *Open to any level of rider competing on any 4 or 5 yr old horse as of Jan 1 of current show year, ridden in a regulation snaffle bit or regulation hackamore with closed reins; and have not been shown down the fence in a bridle at any judged cow horse event anytime, anyplace.
- *Must use the same equipment in all three events
- *To enter the stallion incentive you must enter the Open or Level one Open Derby. Only horses nominated to the Saskatchewan Stallion Incentive are eligible for Stallion Incentive.
- * SRCHA membership required to compete in Stallion Incentive Classes
- * All NRCHA rules apply

Non Pro Derby

- *.Open to approved Non Pro riders only (NRCHA rule) for more info see NRCHA Non Pro definitions and rules
- Open to any 4 or 5 yr old horse as of Jan.1 of the current show year in a regulation snaffle bit, or regulation hackamore; and have not been shown down the fence in a bridle at any judged cow horse event anytime, anyplace.
- * All NRCHA rules apply
- * *To enter stallion incentive you must enter the non pro or level 1 NP derby. Only horses nominated to the Saskatchewan Stallion Incentive are eligible for Stallion Incentive.
- * SRCHA membership required to compete in Stallion Incentive Classes

Non Pro Boxing Derby

- * Open to approved Non Pro Limited riders who comply with all NRCHA non pro eligibility rules and meet requirements of ownership rule
- * in rein box class competing on a 4 or 5yr old horse as of Jan 1 of current show year in a regulation snaffle bit or regulation hackamore
- * Open to horses 6yr of age as of Jan 1 of current show year but **must** be shown in regulation snaffle bit (NRCHA guideline)

- * *To enter stallion incentive you must enter the non pro boxing derby. Only horses nominated to the Saskatchewan Stallion Incentive are eligible for Stallion Incentive.
- * SRCHA membership required to compete in Stallion Incentive Classes
- * All NRCHA rules apply

NRCHA Weekend Horse Show Class Guidelines

Weekend Classes

- *Entry consists of rein-fence or rein-box and rider can enter one day or both days. No Herd Work for Weekend Classes.
- * Money will be paid out as per NRCHA payout,
- *NRCHA membership is required
- *All NRCHA rules apply

NRCHA Spectaculars

- *Spectaculars consist of Herd, Rein, and Fence/ Box
- * Spectaculars will run concurrent with Horse Show day 1 classes and those scores will be added to herd work score
- * Cross entry discount of \$75 if entered in both Spectacular and Weekend Horse Show Class
- * Non Pro Boxing Spectacular is not a bridle class, Can use legal equipment for age of horse.

Saskatchewan Reined Cow Horse Association Weekend Classes

- *Must have SRCHA membership
- *No NRCHA membership is required

SRCHA 5000 Limit, 2500 Limit and 500 Limit

- *These classes will be in a common draw with the NRCHA Non Pro Bridle Class. Payouts will still be per class

SRCHA 1000 Limit NP Boxing and 500 Limit NP Boxing

- * These classes will be in a common draw with the NRCHA Limited Non Pro Boxing class. Payouts will still be per class

Stallion Incentive Open Bridle, Non Pro Bridle and Non Pro Boxing

- * To enter the Stallion Incentive must be cross entered in either the Open Bridle or Non Pro Class (Non Pro Fence Class at any level/or Non Pro Boxing Class at any level)
- * Open Bridle Stallion Incentive is NRCHA approved, NP Bridle and Non Pro Boxing Stallion incentive is NOT NRCHA approved.
- * SRCHA membership required to compete in Stallion Incentive Classes

Concurrent Classes: (Cross entry discount and only one video fee if cross entering)

- Open and Level 1 Open Futurity, Non Pro and Level 1 Non Pro Futurity \$175 X Discount
- Open and Level 1 Open Derby, Non Pro and Level 1 Non Pro Derby \$175 X Discount
- Open Bridle/Ltd Open Bridle \$95 X Discount
- NP Bridle/ Int NP Bridle/ Level 1 NP Bridle/ SRCHA 5000 Limit/ SRCHA 2500 Limit/ SRCHA 500 Limit Fence \$95 X Discount each
- Open Hackamore/ Ltd Open Hackamore \$95 X Discount
- Non Pro Boxing/ Int NP Boxing \$65 X Discount
- Limited NP Boxing/SRCHA 1000 Limit/SRCHA 500 Limit NP Boxing \$65 X Discount

Stalls:

- * Fee covers Thursday night through Saturday night
- * Please bring your own bedding.
- * Classic Cow Horse Show Management will have shavings available for \$10 per bag (Please pre book as many as you think you will need so we can order ahead. Not many extras will be ordered.)
- * No straw is allowed.
- * If possible please only bring those horses to be shown/ and or herd help. Stall space is limited.
- *Extra Nights stall rental \$35/night Please add to entry form

Video Fee:

*Video fee has been added to your entry form. The videos from your show will be available to view on sight and will also be available to download following the show.

Camping:

- There are 8 electrical spots available in the Ag Centre Parking Lot. They are mostly 20amp plug-ins so an adaptor may be necessary. Bring an extension cord to make sure you can reach the box.
- There is an additional camping area (electrical and water) located East of the Ag Centre (~ ¼ mile away). Extra large units can pull through the middle row. Washrooms available there (no shower). There are two showers available in the Ag Centre.
- Camping fees are paid with entry fees but please Email classiccowhorse@gmail.com separately to **reserve a spot**. Reservations are first-come, first-serve.

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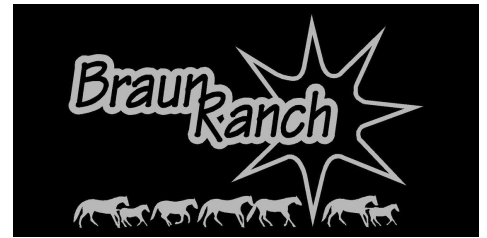

***The Cowboy Class** is a fence class that is open to any rider who has \$1000 or less in Cow Horse Competition earnings. The goal is to introduce working cowboys to the sport of reined cow horse. Horses can be any age and rider may ride one OR two handed in split reins with shank bit or any legal NRCHA equipment (snaffle bit, hackamore, 1 handed Romel Rein). You can use either leather or chain curb straps. No tie downs or martingales. Note this is **not an NRCHA or SRCHA class**. No memberships required. Ownership of horse is not required. This is a modified pattern with no lead changes and only 2.5 spins each way. Rider will complete their rein work pattern, rider will then do a partial fence run by boxing the cow and getting two fence turns, rider will not circle the cow, but instead will then shake down a loop and rope cow (using breakaway Honda). 2 Loops or 60 second limit, whichever comes first. No chaps required.

Buckaroo Ranch Hand Boxing (Under 13): This class is open to riders 13 years of age and younger as of January 1 of the current year. This class will use a modified pattern with no lead change and 2.5 spins. Open to any horse of any age (but ownership rule is not required to be met). May ride one handed or two in legal bit. No chaps required. Note this is **not an NRCHA or SRCHA class**. No memberships required.

General Information:

*By submitting an entry in any format, entrant acknowledges that they meet the criteria to compete in the class entered according to the guidelines set forth and according to NRCHA rules

* NRCHA membership can be purchased on the NRCHA website, or at show office, owners need to have NRCHA memberships.

*The Classic Cow Horse reserves the right to accept or reject any entry

*All forms, waivers and copy of registration papers must be complete

*Riders are responsible to check in at show office **prior to showing** to ensure entry and paperwork is in good standing before entering show ring.

**2026 SRCHA Membership can be purchased at show office. Membership Forms can be found on SRCHA website. Owners and Riders must both be members for SRCHA classes

*Grade horses shown in any NRCHA approved class must have filed for Grade Horse registry through NRCHA as per NRCHA rule (in place 2017)

*If the show is cancelled for any reason all fees will be returned.
